#### **Healthcare Programs**

- Medicaid: Free or low-cost health coverage for families and children.
- All Kids (CHIP): Comprehensive health insurance for children.

#### Education and Childcare

- Head Start: Early childhood education, health, and nutrition services.
- Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP): Financial help for childcare costs.

# Family Support Services

- Disability Benefits (SSI/SSDI): Financial aid for individuals with disabilities.
- Respite Care: Relief services for primary caregivers.

# Mental Health and Counseling

- Behavioral Health Services: Individual and family counseling.
- Trauma-Informed Care Programs: Support for children affected by trauma.

# Community and Legal Aid

- Housing Assistance: Section 8 vouchers and emergency housing.
- Legal Aid Services: Support with custody, healthcare appeals, and immigration matters.

# Work and Financial Support

- LIHEAP: Help with home energy costs.
- Job Training Programs: Skill-building and employment assistance.
